



## **Associate Board Member Information & Application**

Licking County Soil & Water Conservation District (LCSWCD) Board of Supervisors is seeking qualified associate board members who wish to utilize their knowledge, skills and expertise in helping the district fulfill its mission. Associates attend board meetings, and with training and guidance may:

- ✓ serve on board committees by appointment;
- ✓ help plan, promote and implement district programs, activities, field days, etc.;
- ✓ represent the district at various meetings and events; and
- ✓ present district programs to individuals, groups and organizations.

Associate board members serve one-year terms from the date of appointment, with a three-month probationary period. There is no limit on the number of times associates may be re-appointed. Associate board members must also commit to attending at least two-thirds of the district's monthly meetings.

This service provides excellent training for individuals who may want to run for election to the Board of Supervisors. Interested individuals may complete an application and return it to the district program administrator.

The LCSWCD is a political subdivision of the state of Ohio. It is governed by a five-member Board of Supervisors who are elected by the residents and landowners of Licking County.

Board members oversee district programs implemented by the staff and conservation partners. This oversight includes: identifying and prioritizing soil, water and related natural resource needs in Licking County; coordinating with local, state and federal conservation partners to plan and promote conservation programs; and providing leadership, education and assistance to landowners and natural resource users. Elected Board members serve a three-year term as a public official.
