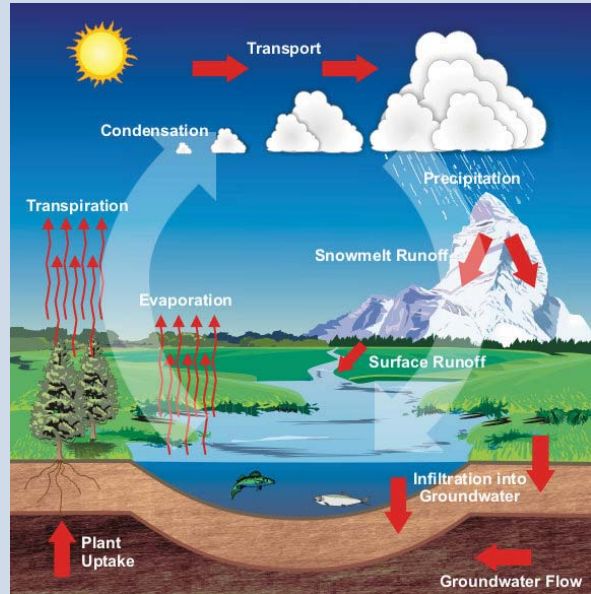


Got WATER?

Did you know ...

- Only 1% of water on earth is available for humans to use.
